AT HHW DAY OR TRUDEAU TRANSFER STATION

- Ammunition, Explosives & Gunpowder (Contact your local Police Department for safe disposal)
- Asbestos
- Susiness Waste
 (This collection is only for residential waste)
- Construction Debris
- Empty Containers

(A container is considered empty when no more than one inch or 3% [by weight] of material is left in the container, these can be disposed of in the regular trash)

- Fire Extinguishers (Contact your local Police Department for safe disposal)
- Freon
- Marine Flares

(Pyrotechnic flares cannot be accepted at the collection because they are categorized as explosives)

○ Ice Melts

(Dispose of in the regular trash)

- Solidify then dispose of in the regular trash)
- Medicine, Drugs, Needles & Syringes
 (Find safe and secure disposal near you)
- **O Propane Tanks**

(Contact your local hardware store, propane swap location or propane provider for safe disposal)
