Friday, June 14th 11:30am in the Meeting Room


Sean O'Brien from the UNH Extension Education Center will teach the basics of water-bath canning by going through the steps of making jam. Water-bath canning is used to preserve



high acid foods, such as jams, pickles, and some tomatoes. Using tested recipes and procedures protects you and your family from harmful bacteria. Canning keeps your food shelf-stable, so you can enjoy your favorite seasonal foods all year round.

Tuesday, June 25th 11am At the Colonial Theater






The collection is comprised of:
