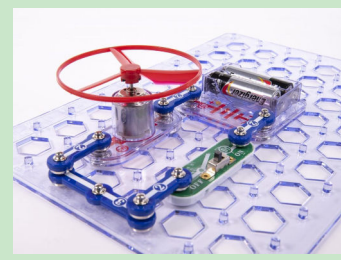
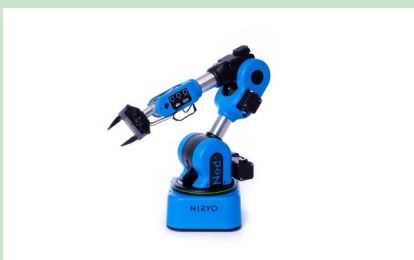

Learn to play this popular tile-based game. It's not like playing online!

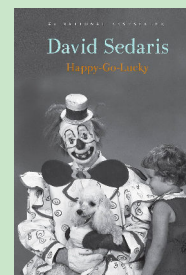

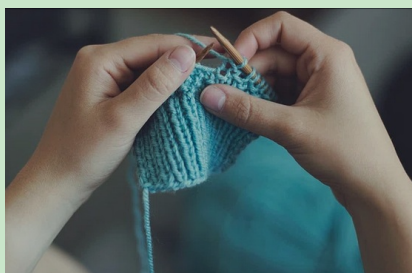


Special Event: Renee Rows the Atlantic!
