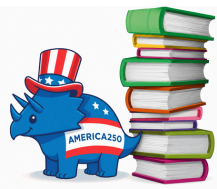

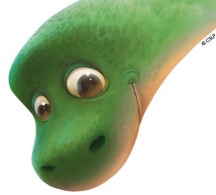
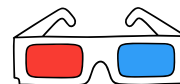
Finding fossils, casting our own handprints in plaster, and other paleontology projects.
